

Mayor who decided against meeting Councillors one-on-one.



Timetables Still Wrong - Incompetent **Metro / WYCA Responsible**

There are two large timetable posters at Wetherby bus station. Metro / WYCA updated one (many weeks after the new X98/99 started) but not the other. It has contained wrong times for 2 months now.

In the library there are no bus timetable leaflets for 3 of our services (8, 174 & 492). Metro are duty-bound to print timetable leaflets for those routes where the bus company does not. So why don't they? You would hope our Leeds City Councillor and representative on the board of Metro/ WYCA would be active on issues like this. We wrote to him:

WYCA / Metro, I have not noticed any improvement in their performance or standards. Indeed it has got worse in one of their

Reminder of Bus Facts for Councillors & MP, Alec Shelbrooke

- Before Oct 2025 non-car owners subsidised motorists through Council Tax to maintain free car parks
- \Diamond Costs £4 return to Knaresborough, £5 return to Leeds, Otley, York & Garforth and £5/£6 return to Harrogate on the X70/7
- Harrogate Bus Co's route 7 to Harrogate & Leeds via B Spa was reduced to hourly from half-hourly in Nov '22
- Harrogate Bus Co cut the 11.30pm bus on route 7 from Harrogate in Nov '22. Last bus now 10.20pm (but 12.25am to K'boro) \Diamond
- \Diamond NO WEEKEND service to York (Connexion's route 412) or Otley (Connexion's route 923) since May 22
- WYCA/Metro made a big mess in Wetherby of installing new bus stop flags in 2021. Half the stops are still the old type
- Their 7 invaluable bus guide network maps are online only. The Wharfedale one is not even displayed at W'by Bus Sta.

The Labour Mayor Tracy Brabin is ultimately responsible for WYCA / Metro performance. They will have more staff and power when franchising comes in. They were the worst performing local transport authority in a national survey in both 2023 & 2024. Opinion based on above facts and many others: Metro / WYCA are a large bureaucracy with low standards and a poor record.

Sad Decline of Local Journalism



We are recording the number of general news items about Wetherby / Boston Spa & villages. And the number of letters/emails from residents about the area in the published paper, costing £2.20.

We do this in the hope they will wake up and take up some of our stories. Not so far - they are ignoring almost all of the serious issues in our great town and do not deserve to have the word 'Wetherby' in their title.

It makes our role more important than ever.

Last year we monitored 48 editions of the paper and found there were just over 1 item of 'news' (often a press release) on average costing readers £1.91 per item. And just 1 letter in the whole year from a Wetherby area person. This year is looking the same.

In our last edition we offered to give our wonderful charity volunteers a lift to their shop because of the new charges in the Wilderness car park. This affects a substantial number of workers, according to our councillors who opposed the charges, particularly ClIr Lamb.

We asked Cllr Lamb to promote our offer on social media. He refused to do so because of his concerns regarding 'safeguarding and insurance'.

We explained to ClIr Lamb that the Editor was a popular, reliable volunteer driver for WISE for many years with no complaints.

We also pointed out the obvious; that the charity shop manager is responsible for any safeguarding issue, not him. Managers will no doubt interview the Editor or anyone else in depth.

We told ClIr Lamb that the Editor often gives his elderly neighbour a lift to his holiday coach drop-off point, no money exchanged. How is that any different from our offer? It does not invalidate any insurance.

It seems to us that ClIr Lamb is using excuses not to help resolve a problem that he claims is a large one. It is bizarre that he is so reluctant to help support a practical solution.

We have been disappointed with Cllr Lamb's attitude before eg bus blocking issue - his main advice was to get passengers to report the incidents to police.



No Bus Station on Council Leaflet!



Issues 54 & 55 - No apology from Cllr Buckle or anybody else for this large error. This leaflet is the only printed marketing material they have produced. After years in the planning, the final

product was dull and many images were far too small and dark to make any impression. Half of the picture of a bus was the road! The bandstand photo had no band in it. There is not a single smiling face in the leaflet. How is that for a 'Welcome to Wetherby'? No consultation, no advertising found to pay for it, so the taxpayer (us) forked out for £1500 for the design alone.

Comparison with Otley



Issue 19 compared our marketing literature with Otley's. Our neighbouring town along the Wharfe is similar to ours and makes the most of its natural assets and character. The higher quality of their output is obvious. We had 4 lower quality leaflets in 2022 and nothing much has changed since we reported on it then.

There is much more evidence to show just how little this committee has achieved, compared to other towns.

Another of their teams in the Barkston Ash Crown Green League (this is a Leeds league) came top of the



Sandbeck Est Brewery in GBG 2026



Goosemoor Nature Reserve in Cowthorpe



Wrong Bus Info on Town Council Website te in Sep '22, Out-of-date All this info has been in our only commi newsletter, the Wetherby Free Press, so We sent this to all Town Councillors & Iona Taylor, Town Clerk politely asking them to update their website. We will report in the next issue whether they have done so. We wait to see if they explain how this can happen and who is responsible This is more proof of low standards at this Town Council and proof that Wetherby Councillors (like Clir Norma Harrington, who claims to take an interest in buses) do not monitor the contents of their own website. Wetherby Deserves Better.

Last year we had to point out the errors misleading visitors and residents about the only public transport in town - buses. Proof they don't care about buses or checking that website information is updated. Their solution - remove ALL bus info!

Still No Newsletter after 2 years

Local Businessman Complains - Tender £2000 cheaper than winning tender. Appeal of complaint rejected.

The minutes of an Appeals meeting in Sept below are very concerning. The accusations are serious, particularly the claim that he was not given a reason why he wasn't awarded the contract. It sounds like he'd had enough and left the meeting. If he wants to get in touch with us to tell us why, please do so. If unhappy with the conduct of the Town Council or Councillors, he should email councillorconduct@leeds.gov.uk. We say 'well done' to him for sticking up for himself - not easy in this town.

Complaint in respect of the tender process for the replacement of the railings at Garden of Rest. The Town Clerk gave a brief update on the process so far. Members of the appeals committee were updated of the complaint and the decision made by the complaints committee

The complainant was given the time to outline and explain his concerns to the committee members, some of which were

- The complainant believes that the tender process was not carried out correctly, the complainant expected a format that allowed a points system to be utilised for marking the tender thoroughly which would advise which areas didn't meet the specification adequately.
- Their tender came in £ 2000 cheaper than the awarded business. As a Wetherby resident and business, they had hoped that you would be awarded the contract.
- Claimant stated that he did not receive a response as to why he wasn't awarded the contract.
- Claimant asked how the Council deemed the decision as best value process.

Members of the committee addressed the above matters with the complainant with due consideration. Explanations were given as to how the tender process was carried out and that all businesses who tendered were given the same specification/information. The contract was awarded to the business that fully complied with the specification, as outlined at the complaints committee meeting.

The complainant left the meeting at this point.

The committee discussed the appeal to the decisions made and concerns in great depth. It was RESOLVED

The Council sav thev discussed this case 'in great depth' but unusually the Town Clerk did not minute when the meeting ended so we have no clue as to how long it lasted. Poor minuting yet again.

Local Business Upset with Wetherby Town Council




Public criticism of the *Town Council* in writing is rare outside these pages. So we must take seriously the concerns of one local business that dares to speak out.


